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Objectives

- CREATE a fun and exciting environment encouraging students to explore their musical expression
- DISCOVER where the student is in her/his musical journey and proceed in furthering their skills as a musician
- ESTABLISH a strong foundation of the art of practice and to educate the student on different genres of music
- DEVELOP musical awareness and creation of expression in performance

Logistics

- **Instructor's Studio** - Located [REDACTED]. Students will have access to all the necessary materials for the lesson including: a music stand, pencils, staff paper, metronome, tuner, and applicable electronics.
- **Student's Home** - Must be a space with no distractions to the student. The best option for a student home lesson space is in a parlor room or dining room. It is discouraged to have the lesson space in the living room, kitchen, or playroom. The student home lesson space must be equipped with: a music stand, pencil, two chairs, and a quiet learning environment.
- **Virtual Studio** - Must have internet access and a quiet learning environment, similar to the "Student's Home" requirements. The computer used must have a free account of Skype, video camera (internal or external), and an external microphone if possible. The space must be in a well-lit room with a music stand, staff paper, and pencils.

Expenditures

- At the beginning of each month, all lessons will be paid for in advance. If there are any last minute missed lessons that occur in that month, you will still be held liable for that lesson's payment. If notified in advance (at the beginning of the monthly payment) you will not be held liable for payment.
